## WHAT DO YOU PARTAKE OF DURING THE SACRAMENT?

## WHAT DO THESE EMBLEMS REPRESENT?

**Christ's Body**

**Christ's Blood**

## WHAT GREAT SACRIFICE DOES EACH REPRESENT?

Christ suffered and experienced  
**Physical Death**

Christ suffered for our sins and experienced  
**Spiritual Death**

The perfect "Lamb of God" sacrificed his body by allowing it to be killed. Christ experienced Physical Death

The perfect "Lamb of God" sacrificed his spirit by suffering for our sins. Christ experienced Spiritual Death.

## WHAT WAS THE RESULT?

Christ Overcame  
**Physical Death**

Christ Overcame  
**Spiritual Death**

Physical corruption results in Physical Death which separates you from your body.

Spiritual corruption (aka Sin) results in Spiritual Death which separates you from God.

## WHAT ARE THE NAMES OF THESE EVENTS?

**Resurrection**

**Redemption**

Jesus rose from the tomb. He saved us by breaking the bands of death.

Jesus Christ redeemed us with his blood.

## HOW DOES THAT DIRECTLY AFFECT YOU?

**Reunites you with your body forever**

**Reunites you with God forever**

Through Jesus Christ, the separation of death is reversed.

Through Jesus Christ, the separation caused by sin is reversed.

**Immortality**

**Eternal Life**

Immortality is living forever.

Eternal Life is living with God.
